THE DREAM OF THE ENCORE AZALEAS

The Encore Azalea™ story originated with the dream of Robert E. Lee of Independence, Louisiana. His vision was to recreate the beauty of spring flowering azaleas in other times of the year. In the early 1980's, Mr. Lee began a methodical breeding effort to achieve his goals by hybridizing beautiful, spring flowering varieties with a rare, summer blooming azalea. This resulted in thousands of different twice-blooming azaleas. Each plant was then evaluated for flowering period and richness of color, as well as quality of foliage and overall vigor. The result of this lengthy process is the release of the Encore Azaleas™.

THE REPEAT PERFORMANCE

After they flower in the spring, the Encore Azaleas™ begin growing. New shoots appear, suddenly stop growing, and start setting buds. The azalea's "first act" opens when the early buds begin blooming into full flower in mid-summer. The curtain drops on this unique bloom season with the onset of cold weather. But, the show goes on. As an "encore," these exceptional azaleas flower again with traditional spring azaleas, and the process starts over again.

Be careful planting Encore Azaleas™ in regions much colder than here. They were bred in Louisiana and we have seen no hardiness information on these varieties.
