V. awabuki 'CHINDO'	Chindo Evergreen	7-10 10' x 6'	This broadleaf evergreen plant grows fast with large rich green lustrous leaves. The plant can be grown as a small tree or large shrub and is a good substitute for Photinia as a hedge. Tolerates shade.
V. davidii	David Evergreen	7-9 3' x 6'	Forms a low, compact, 3 to 5' high mound of thick, dark blue-green, evergreen foliage. Pink budded, flat white flowers, 2 to 3" wide in April-May. Blooms made up of 30 smaller flowers. A highlight is plants interesting creased leaf all year round,
V. denatum 'NORTHERN BURGUNDY' ®	Arrowwood Deciduous	3-7 8' x 8'	Selected for its broad upright rounded form, better than the species, early fall burgundy foliage. Creamy white, flat-topped flowers appear in mid May followed by ornamental clusters of blue-black fruit in autumn.
V. dilatatum 'ASIAN BEAUTY'	Linden Deciduous	4-8 8' x 6'	An upright, compact shrub with dark green foliage and creamy white flowers in late spring. The fruit is an outstanding cherry red color that holds its color throughout the winter. Bloom is flat topped and made up of lots of tiny flowers. Profuse flowers cover plant with creamy white veil.
V. dilatatum 'BLUE MUFFIN' ™	Linden Deciduous	3-7 6' x 6'	An exciting new compact selection of Arrowwood Viburnum perfect for residential landscapes. This compact beauty has loads of white spring flowers, and an impressive display of rich blue berries. Makes a great low hedge or foundation plant.
V. dilatatum 'CARDINAL CANDY' ™	Linden Deciduous	4-7 5' x 5'	A special plant with improved hardiness and abundant, persistent shiny scarlet red fruit. Discovered in a batch of seed-grown plants after a -30degree cold spell killed off all except Cardinal Candy. Tons of creamy white fertile flowers cover this well branched rounded plant in May. Fruiting appears strong even without another pollinator.
V. dilatatum 'CATSKILL' *	Linden Deciduous	5-8 5' x 5'	A compact grower with small, round leaves and good autumn color. Flat white blooms are made up of very small fertile flowers. It has dark red long lasting fruit in Aug. and yellow to red autumn foliage.
V. dilatatum 'ERIE' *	Linden Deciduous	5-8 6' x 8'	Excellent bushy compact shrub. Abundant creamy white flowers, completely cover the plant in May. Bloom is flat made up of 300 or more tiny fertile flowers. Coral pink fruit, is most intense after few heavy frosts and persist until late winter, Fruits so numerous they bend branches to the ground. Hairy leaves shows lots of veins turning yellow-orange-red in autumn.
V. dilatatum 'IROQUOIS' *	Linden Deciduous	4-7 5' x 8'	Large, thick, dark green leaves and creamy white flowers cover plant in mid-May. The large, glossy red fruit ripens in Aug. and persists until midwinter. Orange-red to maroon fall color. Catskill and Iroquois are mutual pollinators.
V. dilatatum 'MICHAEL DODGE'	Linden Deciduous	4-7 5' x 5'	Selected at the famous Winterthur Gardens. Large, abundant, creamy white flowers appear in May. Its large, eye-catching yellow berries glow against a backdrop of scarlet red autumn foliage. Use Viburnum Cardinal Candy as a Pollinator for good berries.
V. nudum 'WINTERTHUR'	Witherod Deciduous	5-9 5' x 5'	Smooth Witherod. A compact rounded shrub with dark glossy green leaves and creamy white flat cupped flowers in late June to early July. The pink and blue fruit on this viburnum is also an added plus. Autumn coloration is a superb burgundy red.
V. opulus	European Cranberry Deciduous	3-8 10' x 10'	Multi-stemmed shrub with glossy green leaves and white flowers in the spring. Does not develop significant autumn foliage color. It has lacy 3-4 inch round clusters of white flowers in late spring and red fruit which last from late summer well into winter
V. opulus 'Roseum'	European Cranberry Deciduous	3-8 10' x 10'	Snowball bush. Rounded plant with its masses of white flowers in June. No fruit because it's sterile One of the oldest cultivars whose name "Roseum" refers the the inflorescence's snowball shape, not its color.
V. p. tomentosum 'PINK BEAUTY'	Doublefile Deciduous	5-8 6' x 6'	Pink and white pinwheels! Flowers open white but soon transform to light pink with age. Abundant flowers, attractive red fruit and reddish purple fall color make this shrub a "Pink Beauty." Requires cold winter temperatures to express pink coloration.

V. p. tomentosum 'SHASTA' *	Doublefile Deciduous	5-8 6' x 10'		Glistening white, large, flat flowers seem to float on its graceful, tiered branches in May. Plant resembles a dogwood in shrub form. Excellent corner foundation plant. Bright red fruits are an ornamental attraction in July before providing a summer picnic for fruit-eating birds like Robins.
V. p. tomentosum 'SNOWFLAKE'	Doublefile Deciduous	5-8 5' x 5'		Compact deciduous shrub much like Watanabei, with the exception of being smaller, snowflake flowers open intermittently all summer
V. p. tomentosum 'WATANABEI' *	Doublefile Deciduous	5-8 6' x 6'		Continuous flowering from spring until frost, outstanding irregular dwarf specimen with character and color! White, flattened, lace-dolly-like 2-4" flower clusters have a mass of small fertile flowers bordered with an outer ring of showy sterile flowers
V. rhytidophyllum 'CREE' *	Leatherleaf Evergreen	5-7 8' x 8'		A large multi-stemmed shrub with large leathery dark green leaves. In May it has lightly fragrant blooms that are fuzzy, cream white, fertile. It's flowers are not spectacular individually but very attractive when the plant is enveloped in blooms. In fall it has red fruit which matures to black.
V. Tinus	Tinus Evergreen	7-9 8' x 8'		Bloom buds pink in fall opening to 2-3" white cluster flowers in early Spring with a light fragrance. Excellent plant for screening and can withstand a considerable amount of shade. Has lustrous, dark-green leaves 2-3in. long. Southern plant. Attractive winter plant.
V. Tinus 'SPRING BOUQUET'	Tinus Evergreen	5-8 4' x 4'		Rounded and more compact than Tinus, also offers dark red flower buds in fall that open to white in Spring. Attractive throughout fall, winter, and spring. Leaves are smaller than Tinus. More cold hardy than species Tinus.
V. X burkwoodii 'CONOY' *	Semievergreen	6-8 5' x 7'		Fine textured, glossy green leaves with creamy white, slightly fragrant, waxy flowers in April. Has a distinct, low-mounding habit. A profusion of glossy dark red fruit by mid August, turning to black in October
V. X burkwoodii 'MOHAWK' *	Semievergreen	4-8 5' x 5'		A compact grower with glossy dark green leaves that turn a nice orange fall color. This viburnum also has outstanding dark red flower buds for a few weeks that open to reveal white waxy flowers in March - April. Flower is strongly scented with a sweet-spicy fragrance that carries throughout the yard. Is resistant to leaf spot and powdery mildew.
V. X carlcephalum	Fragrant Snowball Deciduous	4-7 6' x 6'		Large fragrant snowball flowers adorn this beauty in late April. Pink buds, white 5" flowers and wine fall color make this plant a standout. Red to black fall fruit.
V. X carlcephalum 'CAYUGA' *	Deciduous	5-8 6' x 6'		A compact grower that produces an abundance of pink buds followed by white fragrant flowers in late April-May. When open the inflorescence is densely crowded & forms a tight snowball with a strong fragrance. Red to blue-black fruit.

Viburnum plicatum tomentosum are called double-file viburnums because their flower clusters are borne in pairs making a double row all along the flowering branch accentuating the horizontal branching that is characteristic of this species. They are considered one of the most beautiful of the flowering shrubs. Their flowers resemble snowflakes with a cluster of small fertile flowers in the center surrounded by a row of larger sterile flowers.
